## EXPLANATION OF STANDARDS-BASED GRADE REPORTING AND CLASS PROFILE

### **EXPLANATION OF STANDARDS-BASED GRADE REPORTING:**

Hall-Dale High School's use of standards-based grade reporting is focused on providing students, parents, teachers, school leadership and the community with the most accurate and useful information possible regarding student progress.

All classes have clearly identified content standards that are individually assessed and reported on using a one through four scale:

4 = Proficient with Distinction; 3 = Proficient; 2 = Partially Proficient; 1 = Not Proficient.

At the conclusion of the school year "final standards grades" are reported for all standards in a given class. These final standards grades are then averaged to produce a "final course grade." The final course grade is posted to the transcript and serves as the basis for the calculation of a standards-based GPA (SBGPA) which determines class rank. Students must earn a final course grade of 2.500 or better to earn credit for a course.

#### **Final Course Grade Example: Geometry**
